<p>Group from Sweden brought the desk. Group from Slovakia brought the stand. Group from Ireland brought the frame.</p> <p>We have discussed where to fix frames and how to fix them. Possibility of fixing with glue and where to fix it depends on the size of all puzzle map.</p> <p>We will fix the desk to the stand in the shape of the letter Z. We decided we will have a fixed angle. There will be two aluminium “spider legs” which will hold the fixed angle. The angle of the desk will be fixed at 20°.</p> <p>We will need 3 screws to fix the back frame from the bottom. It is overhanging by 5 mm deep.</p> <p>Slovakia must do the spider legs triangle and bring it to Bad Kreuznach. It should be drilled and threaded for fixing to the bottom of the desk. Assembling these should take only 15 – 20mins.</p>
